For the past 25 years, Mel Hiki has been an award-winning art director working with Charles Schulz for MeLife, Warner Bros. and Will Vinton Studios for KFC. He's created original characters for KFC, International and Lumpy Natural Foods. From Mel's involvement with community service and love for creating characters, he wrote, illustrated, and self-published his first children's book on hunger awareness, *The Other Side of The Pond*. The book is based on an outreach event Mel organized with his church.
